All internships last for 90 days (~3 months) maximum and can start as early as May 2026 or as late as October 2026. Selected participants 1) will receive up to \$5,000 to off-set the cost of their experience abroad, 2) must enroll at OSU during the time of their internship abroad to earn credit for the experience abroad and 3) must also register their travel in [the OIA travel registry](#) and purchase mandatory insurance coverage.
